### **CITY CREWS QUICKLY REPAIR MAJOR BREAK IN HARBOR WATER MAIN**

On Monday evening at approximately 9:00 PM, an eight-inch water main suffered a major break in the 32000 block of North Harbor Drive. This location is at the lowest elevation of the City's water system. Consequently, the large water leak lowered water pressures to noticeably below normal throughout the city. A Public Works crew responded quickly to isolate the break and minimize the disruption to customers. The crew arrived shortly after 9:00 PM and worked through the night to replace the failed section of pipe. The repair was completed at 3:00 AM and the water line was back in service by 4:00 AM. Temporary street repairs have been made at the repair site and permanent paving repairs will be completed later this summer.
