PEG-TV CHANNEL NOW AVAILABLE ON CITY'S WEBSITE 24/7

The City's Public, Education and Government Channel is now available to view on the City's homepage for free 24 hours a day, 7 days per week. The Channel, also known as "The PEG," has been traditionally available only to Comcast Cable subscribers on Channel 3. The PEG broadcasts the City's public meetings live and includes around-the-clock local programming including governmental meetings, local events, sporting events, locally produced shows covering a wide array of topics such as current events, health & wellbeing, history, arts and culture and more.

"The City is thrilled to be able to offer this free service not only to City residents and visitors who subscribe to Comcast, but to anyone who has access to the internet," says City Manager Tabatha Miller. "We continue to add local content, including local governmental meetings, and want to ensure it is accessible to everyone. Having the PEG available on the home page of the City's website goes a long way toward that goal."

The PEG also has a studio in City Hall East, on East Laurel Street for anyone interested in producing a show or working with City staff to get their own content onto the Channel. Certain governmental regulations and limitations apply. The studio has public hours every Friday afternoon from 1:30 to 5:00pm and other days by appointment.
